Equestrian Rules of Entry

- ❖ 1st prize money will only be awarded in classes with up to 4 entries. 1st & 2nd prize money will be awarded in classes with 5 – 8 entries, 1st 2nd & 3rd prize money will be awarded in classes with 9 or more entries. All prize money MUST be collected on day of the show or will be forfeit.
- ❖ Only Horseboxes and Cars towing trailers will be allowed into the horse parking area. Judges & Stewards will have a designated parking area next to the Equine entry tent.
- ❖ Entries open 1st May 2026 - Please complete the entry form and email to equine@halifaxshow.uk. Postal entries – see entry form for details. Entries close at Midnight, Wednesday 5th August 2026. Entries accepted on the day at the equine tent.
- ❖ Competitor first aid must be paid for when submitting entries.
- ❖ Grooms passes will be issued at 1 per horse/pony/donkey entered. All competitors will automatically receive a pass. Further wrist bands can be purchased when submitting entries. – See entry form for details.
- ❖ The organisers accept no responsibility for loss or damage, injury or accident to spectators, exhibitors, riders or their property as a result of attending this show. Please take appropriate care to prevent such accident or loss to yourselves and others. All competitors must hold suitable Public Liability insurance and a valid equine passport.
- ❖ Equine Influenza – all animals to have received an annual vaccination within 12 months of the show or if have had to start a new course proof of the 1st & 2nd vaccinations will be required.
- ❖ Riders must wear up to date hard hats secured with a chin strap. Hats which bear EN1384 or BSEN1384 along with another accepted standard, will be permitted. For example, BSEN1384 & PAS015 (2011) along with the Kitemark or Inspec IC mark will be acceptable, but not BSEN1384 on its own. This also applies to handlers 15 years and under.
- ❖ Riders must the correct size for the horse/pony and the correct age for the class they wish to compete in. Anyone riding on the showground must be eligible to compete the horse/pony in the class being warmed up for.
- ❖ No persons other than the exhibitor, handler, judges and stewards are allowed into the rings.
- ❖ No horse/pony under 4yrs will be allowed to compete in any ridden class.
- ❖ No exercising of horses or ponies in the parking area. Please use the designated collecting ring only. No cantering/galloping outside of the competition rings. No lunging anywhere on the showground.
- ❖ Age for horse/pony and rider as of 1st January 2026.
- ❖ All stallions and colts should be suitably bitted and handled by persons 16 yrs. and over.
- ❖ The organiser's reserve the right to divide, amalgamate or cancel any classes should entries warrant it.
- ❖ If an entry is late for a class, due to competing in another ring, the judge may wait 5 mins, or allow late entry to the ring, entirely at his/her own discretion. No refunds will be made.
- ❖ The Judge's decision is final. Any formal objections should be made in writing (official form available from the Secretary's marquee) and handed to the Secretary, accompanied by a deposit of £20, before leaving the show. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld. You will be notified of the decision by post.
- ❖ No horse/pony to be left unattended tied outside a horsebox/trailer.
- ❖ No mucking out on the showground and please take all litter home with you.
- ❖ Mistreatment of any animal on the Showground will not be tolerated. The organisers reserve the right to ask anyone to leave.
- ❖ By entering any class, you agree to abide by the rules above. The above rules are additional to the general show rules.
- ❖ Refunds of class entry fees is at the discretion of the Equine secretary.
- ❖ Trophies will be given out at the 2026 show for designated classes but will require a £25.00 deposit to be paid. This will be refunded upon return of the trophy or can be deducted from entries for the 2027 show.
- ❖ Anyone who is found to be speaking to any of the show organisers, Judges and or helpers in a disrespectful manner will be asked to leave the showground without hesitation.

TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is bred traditional gypsy cob. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook). Championships Quest for a Star Championship - TGC - 1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes above may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship as per below rule. ONLY current TGCA members and horse/pony that is already TGCA registered can exhibit in this championship. Membership card and Member's qualification card (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS. Go for Glory Championship - PB -1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA part bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory Championship. For TOYS qualifiers, the handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA members/registered on the date of the show. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Crowning Glory Championships at TOYS.

PURE BRED TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB CLASSES

All classes are open to traditional gypsy cobs, which are of any Colour and meet the TGCA breed standard.

This show is affiliated to the Suffolk Horse Society (SHS) and classes 60A – 63 are qualifiers for championship points for annually awarded trophies and for the Supreme Suffolk Horse Championship.

All entries for In Hand classes must be registered in or eligible for registration in the Pedigree Section of the UK Suffolk Stud book. All entries must state their SHS registration number and full pedigree name including prefix or affix.

All foals must be eligible for registration in the Pedigree Section of the UK Suffolk Stud Book. Both the sire and the dam must be registered and entered in the pedigree section of the UK Suffolk Stud Book.

All stallions must be registered in the Pedigree Section of the UK Suffolk Stud book. All entries must state their SHS registration number, stallion licence number and full pedigree name including prefix or affix. Discretionary entry to a stallion class may be allowed in cases where a licence is pending but not yet issued.

All owners entering their horses must be members of the Suffolk Horse Society.

Special Class – Best Turned-out Suffolk Horse – Free to enter, open to all Suffolk Horses.
